TOM REIDY LEAVING POSITION AT TAMPA CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL

St. Petersburg, FL: The Diocese of St. Petersburg announces that Tom Reidy, principal of Tampa Catholic High School, will be leaving his position at the end of this school year to take a new job at a Catholic high school in Michigan.

Reidy has been a staff member at Tampa Catholic for 18 years; he will be moving to Bloomfield Hills, Michigan where he has accepted the position of President of Brother Rice High School. During his tenure as principal, Tampa Catholic has steadily increased enrollment at a time when other private schools across the country have suffered.
