

CITIES FOR LIFE/CITIES AGAINST THE DEATH PENALTY

November 30 is the World Day of Cities for Life/Cities Against the Death Penalty. On this date, cities across the world mobilize to renounce the death penalty and work for a more civil form of justice. In the State of Florida, 29 people have been exonerated from death row (more than any other state) and 99 people have been put to death since executions resumed in the 1970's. 349 people await execution on Florida's death row. Congregations are invited to toll their bells at 6 pm on November 30 and leave the lights on in the Church overnight as a sign of solidarity. Parishes are also invited to utilize the Prayer to End the Use of the Death Penalty and Prayer of the Faithful for Masses on November 30/December 1.
