


100% of all donations received for the BLA are restricted gifts to be used within the diocese for the sole benefit of the programs and ministries outlined below.

- 19% Seminarian Education and support, Vocation Awareness Programs, Permanent Diaconate Program
- Catholic Charities, parish subsidies and other charitable works that assist people in need
- 11% Youth, Campus and Young Adult Ministries
- Programs and ministries that assist our 70 parishes, 6 missions and 5,300+ parish, school and diocesan personnel
- 9% Office of Marriage, Family and Respect Life and the Tribunal
- 9% Catholic Schools, Office of Sacred Liturgy and Religious Education Programs
- Support to the Virginia Catholic Conference and Chancery offices assisting the Bishop as he leads our parishes and the diocese
- 6% Diocesan development and communication programs
- 6% Spanish Apostolate and Multicultural Ministries
- Evangelization efforts including: INOVA Hospital Ministry,

Nearly 16,500 students are enrolled in our Catholic schools to excel academically and grow in their faith.




Thousands of teens and young people participated in the Diocesan Workcamp, Rally, Life is Very Good and other events.
