

BEST PR&CTICES

- Greet everyone pleasantly, you never know their situation
- Just be a listener
- Be ready to assist those with numbers for resources that are not in your area or church boundaries.
- Have a printed list of Food Pantries ready in your area to give to walkins needing food immediately if you do not have a food pantry at your church.
- Keep bags of canned foods in the office for walk-ins.
- Do not keep money in the office area.
- Everything is done by phone (SVDP). Keeps walk-ins to a minimum.

• When a person calls or stops in that is not in your area, have a list of Church, Diocesan, and Community resources on a bulletin board or in a book for ease of finding needed information .

Aggressive or Belligerent Behaviors

- Remain Calm
- Stay pleasant
- Give a listening ear
- Keep even tone of voice
- Watch body language
- Repeat what you need to say, keep repeating in calm voice
 - I cannot assist you, but here are some resources...
 - I did not say...., I said.....
 - I understand you are upset about.....Let me give you some numbers to call.
 - No, I am not yelling at you.
 - No, I am not being rude, I am trying to give you information.
 - If you continue to use profanity, I am going to need to hang up now.



- Walk-ins who will not leave until they get what they want
 - Have plan for another staff member to be near by and able to hear what is going on so they can alert other staff if necessary or call the Sheriff or police.
 - Wait them out as long as possible. Most eventually leave. Every so often remind them that you have given them resources to use.
- Threatening Phone Calls

If belligerent caller continues to threaten to come to the office, alert necessary staff thru a pager system or some other predetermined method that someone may be coming on the grounds, to lock all outside doors. Have a safety plan.
