

REV. MSGR. STEPHEN BOSSO

was born and raised in Pensacola, Florida. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee in 1978. He has served at St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary since 1985 as faculty and formation council member and as rector and president from 2000 to 2005. He has also served as pastor of St. Rose of Lima in Milton, Florida, from 2011 to 2013.

Monsignor Bosso earned his B.A. and M. Div. degrees at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Worthington, Ohio and earned his Licentiate of Sacred Scripture at the Pontifical Biblical Institute, while also attending the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. In 2018, he completed a D. Min. degree in Homiletics from the Aquinas Institute, in St. Louis.

More recently, he was awarded the Marten Visiting Faculty Fellowship in Preaching, at the University of Notre Dame, South Bend, Indiana, where he assisted in the M. Div. program in 2021.

At the end of the 2022 spring semester, Monsignor Bosso is now embarking on another chapter of priestly ministry - retirement - in which he will return to his diocese to assist in parishes and will be available to preach Advent and Lenten missions.


