Shelters of Hope

Through social services designed to preserve families, encourage self-sufficiency, and promote social justice, **Catholic Charities** brings faith and love to those they serve. This past year, **Catholic Charities** housed and sheltered more than 4,000 people through **Shelters of Hope**, and provided new affordable housing opportunities with the opening of Mercy Oaks Apartments in Tampa, the Pasco Family Shelter for young homeless families with children, and two communities in Hillsborough County, Las Villas and Vincent Oaks. An additional location, St. Benedict Apartments, will be available after construction is completed this year.
