The Saint Leo University Center for Catholic-Jewish Studies and the Florida Holocaust Museum will host a panel of scholars who will discuss the story of Eli Rochelson and the question of Catholic reaction to the Holocaust and displaced persons after the Second World War.

Eli's Story is a moving account of the life of a Holocaust survivor, Eli Rochelson. After his freedom from a concentration camp, Rochelson worked to establish two displaced persons camp hospitals in Germany.

The panel will include two of Eli Rochelson's children, Dr. Meri-Jane Rochelson and Dr. Burt Rochelson, along with Holocaust scholar Dr. Kevin Spicer.
