





- More resources to help increase participation

What aspects of the materials do you think could be improved?

- Simplify the pledge envelopes. Too much verbiage on them.
- More stories of the good uses of donations.
- Being personalized according to the Campaign progress and commitment level (amount donated) by parishioners.
- Half page bulletin inserts
- More focus on the work being done, especially in the copy.

The 2023 Mass, exiclerated at St. Paul Parish in Tampa, drew more than 700 priests and parishioners from parishes across the Diocese and representing various African countries gathered as one unified community to celebrate Mass and worship God together.

"The African Mass was an awesome experience of the unity in diversity of our Catholic Church, I witnessed merishioners of St. Paul Parish in Tampa from diverse ministries and cultural communities working together to set up for the reception which would follow the Mass." said Carlos Flores, Director of diocesan Multicultural Ministries.

The recention that followed afferred the opportunity to continue the celebration and experience. 'At the reception, there was food not only from African countries, but also from other ethnic communities like the Brazilians and the Filipinos," Flores shared, "I sat at a table with persons from Puerto Itico and a couple from Philadelphia who expressed they travel every year to experience the African Mass.

As part of our diocesan Multicultural Ministries, the Black Catholic Commission was established in 2001 in the Diocese. of St. Petersburg for the purpose of supporting the Bishop in providing spiritual, cultural, and social nourishment to Catholics of African descent, thereby facilitating their curichment within the dincese and encouraging them to participute more fully in the life and activities of the Church






