

Nov. 23 - Depart USA; Board overnight flight to Lisbon

Nov. 24 - Arrive Lisbon & Check-in to your hotel

Nov. 25 - City tour of Lisbon. You will have an escorted motor-coach, panoramic city tour of Lisbon, Portugal's capital. Visit the Tagus River and see the Tower of Belem, a fortified 4story tower, the Discoveries Monument, displaying statues of many Portuguese explorers, and visit the late Gothic Jeronimos Monastery, an impressive symbol of Portugal's power and wealth during the "Age of Discovery". You will also try the traditional Portuguese pastry, Pasteis de Belem. After lunch, we celebrate Mass at St. Anthony's Church, the birthplace of St. Anthony. The rest of the afternoon is at your own leisure. Overnight in Lisbon.

Nov. 26 - We depart Lisbon for Fatima. Enroute, we visit Santarem and the Church of St. Stephen, or "Church of the Holy Miracle" in Santarem, site of a 13th century Eucharistic miracle. We continue on to Fatima where in 1917, Mary appeared to the local children and the "miracle of the sun" occurred. Check in to your hotel. We celebrate Mass and visit the apparition sites and houses of the seers. We will have the option to join this evening's International Rosary at 9:30 PM at the Chapel of Apparitions attended by thousands of pilgrims world-wide, followed by the Candlelight Procession.

Nov. 27 - Mass in Fatima, visit Cova de Ira and free time in Fatima for personal devotions. Option to join the Rosary & Candlelight procession at night.


Nov. 28 - Depart Fatima to Porto for Embarkation at AmaSintra Cruise Ship.

DAY VEGA DE TERRÓN, SPAIN - SALAMANCA

Drive to Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Concluding both tours, you will have the opportunity to sample local traditional specialties, such as bôlas de Lamego, bread filled with smoked ham; presunto, a type of dry-cured ham; and Espumante, a Portuguese sparkling wine. DAY PORTO

The colorful city of Porto blends the best of old and new, which you can discover on an escorted tour of the historic quarter, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, including the Cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments; and the São Bento Railway Station, known for its blue and white tile panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history. If you prefer to get more active, you can go on a guided hike. In the afternoon, you'll also enjoy a tasting of Port, Portugal's most renowned contribution to the world of wine. In the evening, relax on board during scenic cruise to Afurada, a magical fishing village, where you can explore during your free time. (B,L,D)
