They are to be reviewed by the priest/deacon. The primary purpose of these questions is to be a pastoral aid in bringing closure to the marriage in question. If you have been divorced once, the answers need not be sent to the Tribunal. If you have been divorced more than once, please forward the answers to the Tribunal.

A SIMPLE "YES" OR "NO" IS NOT SUFFICIENT.

1. When did you become acquainted with your former spouse? How often did you date after meeting?
2. When did you decide to marry and how old were you? Were you both enthused about the idea of marriage? How long were you engaged?
3. Was your engagement ever broken? Were there any special problems during the courtship/engagement or the days prior to the wedding?
4. Did you have any doubts about the marriage or did anyone advise against the marriage?
5. With 20/20 hindsight, were there any warning signs present during courtship which you should have heeded?
6. Were there any unusual conflicts on the wedding day or honeymoon?
7. Was the marriage entered into with mutual love or would you or others characterize the relationship as one of infatuation?
8. Was the marriage contracted freely? If there was any force or fear or ultimatum given, please explain.
9. Immediately after the wedding and/or during the marriage were there any special problems experienced in your sexual relations with each other?
10. Did you both enter this marriage intending to have children?
11. If children were born, were they wanted by both of you? Were you and your former spouse both responsible and nurturing parents during the marriage? What is your relationship with your children at present?
12. Did you and your former spouse intend a permanent union binding until death or did one or both of you enter this union with the notion that divorce could be an option?
13. Did either of you believe that infidelity, physical abuse, drugs, lack of love, etc., would dissolve the bond of marriage, freeing that person to marry?
14. In entering this marriage did both of you intend to be faithful to each other for life? Were both of you, in fact, faithful to each other? If not, please explain.
15. How well were you and your former spouse able to communicate? Were you able to share your needs, desires, dreams, anxieties, vulnerabilities? How did you handle disagreements? Please explain.
16. Did the use or abuse of alcohol or drugs affect this marriage? If yes, please explain.
17. When and over what did problems first arise in the marriage?
18. What were your main complaints regarding your former spouse as a spouse and a parent?
19. What were his/her complaints regarding you as a spouse and a parent?
20. When and over what did separations occur in this marriage? When and why did the final separation take place?
21. Describe your former spouse's maturity and emotional stability at the time of the marriage and during the years that followed.
22. Describe your own maturity and emotional stability at the time of the marriage and during the years that followed.
23. As you look back at the time of your marriage, would you say that you exercised good judgement in entering this union? Please explain.
24. With 20/20 hindsight, is there anything you would have done differently which might have preserved this marriage?
25. If you are presently contemplating a new marriage within the Catholic Church, how is your present relationship with your intended spouse different from your relationship with your former spouse?
