Word has reached the Chancellor's Office that Reverend Joseph A. Pastick, age 94, a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago, passed away on Thursday, October 19, 2017 at Southern Pines Healthcare Center, New Port Richey.

Father Pastick was welcomed to the OLH (Our Lady of Humility) parish family in 1975 in Chicago and became involved in a multitude of parish activities, and his presence was enjoyed by the school and religious education students and faculty. In 1995 he retired from active ministry in the Archdiocese of Chicago and relocated to Florida.

He came to Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish that year and assisted with priestly ministry celebrating Mass and making numerous hospital visits over the years. He also served as Chaplain for the Knights of Columbus Council 11680.

On May 31, 2009 he celebrated the 60th Anniversary of his Ordination to the priesthood. He retired from assisting at the parish and moved to Spring Hill in 2011.
