IDEA: REAUTHORIZED 2004

STUDENT PROGRAMS FOR STUDENT BENEFIT

- 1. IDEA involves funding for services to students with disabilities
- 2. Child Find is umbrella for funding for evaluations and identification
- 3. IDEA applies to Pre K programs IF the State of Florida states that public education encompasses pre k thru 12.
- 4. Disability must interfere with academic progress
- 5. Classroom interventions continue to be required in referral process
- 6. Parents required to be involved in all discussions re: academic progress of child
- 7. Public School District (LEA) is responsible for evaluations
 - a. Equitable assessments for all children
 - b. There may be outside evaluators who are approved by district
 - Law allows that the county will only accept their evaluation before deeming a child eliqible for services
- 8. Beginning the date parent signs referral for testing (and submitted to district), the evaluation must be completed within a 60 calendar day period.
 - a. Hint: request referral packet as soon as there is an indication that an eval may be needed. Be pro-active in completing those assigned tasks to eliminate the extra weeks before referral
- Receiving services from LEA involves compliance with FAPE Free and Appropriate Education in Least Restrictive Environment
- 10. IEP is written when a child is formally identified and eligible for services
 - a. The LEA is required by law to explain to the parent that they public school can provide ALL that is required
 - b. Confuses parents.... Give them advance info
 - c. Florida permits dual –enrollment which effects appropriate services
 - d. Service Plan is required by law... substitutes IEP for those students attending non public schools
 - e. Individual entitlement....students are eligible for free and appropriate services in the least restrictive environment
 - i. Child's school (unless compelling reason)
- 11. Consultation is required before all decisions are made
 - a. Must be timely and meaningful
 - b. Applies to all federally funded programs
 - c. You should ask/ know your allocation
 - d. Pooling monies is permissible by law
 - e. Who will provide services/ When start/ how long?
 - f. Concentrated summer programs, after school programs eliminates pull out/ allowable under law
- 12. Problems...
 - a. No money to support service? You can tell them to find the money
 - b. Show me the citation in the law
