

## **Immigration – I-20 Form**

Not all foreign students are required to possess an I-20 form. Only those foreign students who anticipate leaving the borders of the United States while enrolled in school are required to have an I-20 form. An I-20 form must be applied for through the Diocesan Office of Catholic Schools and Centers. The student must be registered at the school in order to apply for an I-20. This form allows a student to visit his or her native country and return to the United States provided the appropriate signatures have been affixed to the I-20 form. Without this form, a student will not be allowed to reenter the country. The school should contact Debbie Kleinberger at the Office of Catholic Schools and Centers for assistance with this.

When a foreign student completes his or her time at a school or withdraws, the office of Catholic Schools and Centers must be notified.
