

The Strategic Intervention Team Model

The Strategic Intervention Team Model (SIT), developed in collaboration with Kansas University and Notre Dame University, provides a vehicle which addresses the needs of those students who have not been evaluated and formally identified as having a special learning need but may be at risk academically and behaviorally. A regular education teacher team will be responsible for discussing, creating and implementing a plan for an individual student in a collaborative/ consultative model with administration, teachers, parent and students.
