From Interstate 275 Southbound:

Take Exit 23B (Fifth Avenue North/FL 595), turn right and proceed Westbound to the Cathedral, approximately 3.6 miles. Cathedral will be on your right on the North side of the road

From Interstate 275 Northbound:

Take Exit 20 (31st Street South), turn left onto 31st street and proceed Northbound (through 4 traffic lights) to Fifth Avenue North, approximately 1.1 miles; then turn left onto Fifth Avenue North and proceed Westbound approximately 2.7 miles. Cathedral will be on your right on the North side of the road.

Immaculée Ilibagiza's Biography

Immaculée Ilibagiza is a survivor of the 1994 Rwandan genocide that took the lives of nearly one million Tutsis. Men, women and children, including her entire family except for one of her brothers, were massacred at the hands of Hutu marauders. Immaculée found shelter at a pastor's home, where she and seven other women hid from the deadly rebel mob in a 3-by-4 foot bathroom for 91 days. During those 91 days of unimaginable suffering, Immaculée found her faith, taught herself English, and most incredibly, committed herself to a life of peace, hope and forgiveness, even for those who had murdered her family.

After the Genocide finally ended, Immaculée found work at the United Nations, emigrating from Rwanda to the United States in 1998. She has gone on to receive five honorary doctoral degrees, written seven books about her faith and her life journey, and is the recipient of the Mahatma Ghandi International Award for Reconciliation and Peace.

This retreat includes her witness of the power of prayer, miracles of the Rosary, and inspirational music. No one will leave this retreat the same as when they came.
